

Scholarship Application for the 2010 Arabic Music Retreat
APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 15, 2010
SCHOLARSHIP DECISIONS WILL BE MADE BY JULY 15, 2010

The Arabic Music Retreat has a limited number of partial scholarships for the 2010 Retreat. These are **partial awards** and will not cover the entire fee for the Retreat. Participants who are awarded scholarships are still expected to provide their own transportation to and from the Retreat. Awards are subject to the availability of scholarship funds and the quality of the applicants, and will be awarded at the discretion of the directors. **Preference will be given to applicants who have previously attended the Arabic Music Retreat, are involved in education (particularly music education), and can demonstrate financial need.** Due to lower available funding this year, there will be fewer scholarships available, and scholarship awards will be lower than in the past.

- All scholarship recipients will stay in the dormitory; both single and double occupancy rooms in the dorm are available for scholarship recipients.
- Recipients must attend the entire Retreat; part-time attendance will not be permitted.
- All scholarships will be awarded in exchange for **part-time work** at the Retreat. All recipients will be expected to help with staff functions, primarily related to set-up, check-in and checkout, daily classroom coordination, open mikes and the recital. These activities will not interfere with your Retreat participation. Please check any and all activities in which you would be willing to contribute some time. Kay Campbell will organize the tasks to run smoothly. In addition to the tasks you choose below, we may assign you to other work if needed.
- Please check any and all tasks in which you could take part. Please check at least two tasks.
 - ___ **Welcoming Tour** – Lead the campus tour for new participants on August 14th. Requires previous participation and knowledge of Retreat and campus.
 - ___ **Check in assistance** – arrive by noon on August 14th and help people check-in, and help those without cars to get their luggage to their dorm rooms. We need one person to help at the desk and preferably two to help with driving people to the dorm.
 - ___ **Check out assistance** – be available by from 9AM to 4PM on August 21st to help people without cars to check out of the dorm and move luggage to Willits. Requires car and/or valid driver's license
 - ___ **Set-up and tear-down team:** Must be available on Sunday in the afternoon to help set up chairs for first rehearsal at Pratt Auditorium, arrange furniture for Open Mikes in Willits and move them back to original position; set up of stage for recital and move chairs and music stands during and after the concert.
 - ___ **Open mike hosting** – Soliciting participants, organizing the evening's play-list, announcing and introducing the events. We will have two open mike nights, plus the final after-recital party that sometimes turns into an open mike.
 - ___ **Concert sound video crew** – Help with sound set-up and assist as needed in the sound booth. Troubleshoot during concert as necessary. One person to shoot a 'backup' video of the recital.
 - ___ **Classroom assistance** – monitors the morning lectures to keep on schedule; manages classroom audio visual equipment. Assists with facilities keys, opening and locking instruments for storage.
 - ___ **General admin team** - helps with check-in, check-out, paperwork preparation, classroom and dorm setup, running errands. Help to pour juice at the recital intermission.
